The Scheme started in Hampshire where a detailed study of minibus driving and in consultation with voluntary and statutory groups operating minibuses. The outcome was that all MIDAS trained drivers will:

- Be assessed to ensure their driving skills are of an acceptable standard.
- Given help where necessary to improve their minibus driving skills.
- Be aware of the legal, practical and safety issues surrounding minibus driving.
- Be trained in the safe use of wheelchair accessible minibuses where necessary.
- Receive a certificate that is acceptable by other MIDAS members.
